and	wrestles with a question or problem.
explore	hooks with the problem and lets the reader watch
	them wrestle with it.
analyze and	The writer
interpret	seeks to analyze and interpret on phenomena that are
	difficult to understand or explain.
take a stand/	The writer
propose a	seeks to persuade audiences to accept a particular
solution	position on a controversial issue.
	describes the problem, proposes a solution, and provides
	justification.
